The pageant fee is \$35 plus \$10 for photogenic. The price to enter both is \$40.

GILLETT HERITAGE DAYS PEOPLE'S CHOICE

To enter: Check the People's Choice box on the pageant application. Submit a 4x6 photo with your application. (Your photo can be in a small plastic sleeve for protection, but it will be taped to a jar.) There is no cost to enter. The contestant with the most money in his or her jar by the final intermission will be crowned and given the title of People's Choice for Heritage Days 2010. The money raised will be used to buy new and additional American flags for the city of Gillett.
