RULES & INFORMATION

The Gillett Civic Group welcomes your entry in the 2010 Heritage Days Pie Baking Contest.

Look forward to an exciting day of activities including the South Wind 5K Run/Walk, antique car and tractor shows, live music, a tug-of-war contest, a talent competition, horseshoe throwing and a BBQ cook-off.

We hope you will enjoy the festivities and put Gillett's Heritage Days on your calendar for next year!

The entry deadline is Friday, May 28, 2010.

The fee is \$10 for the first entry and \$5 for each additional entry.

The Best Overall Pie will receive a grand prize worth \$100.

Contest Rules:

1. Pies must be homemade. All entries must be baked from scratch (no pre-mixes, canned fillings, commercial mixes, puddings, etc.)
2. All entries must be on display by 9:30 am on Saturday, May 29, 2010, at the First Baptist Church fellowship hall. Judging will begin at 10:00 am.
3. Judges will evaluate based on the following criteria:
 - Overall Appearance – 25 points
 - Crust (flavor, texture and aroma) – 25 points
 - Filling (flavor and consistency) – 25 points
 - Originality – 25 points
4. The contest is open to everyone, and each contestant can enter as many pies as they wish (a separate entry form must accompany each pie).
5. A recipe or list of all ingredients per entry is required for judges' protection from food allergies.
